However, it would be much appreciated with you could complete your matches in the allotted time as follows :-

1 <sup>st</sup> Round	<b>Preliminary</b>	End November 2020
2 <sup>nd</sup> Round	<b>Last 32</b>	End November 2020
3 <sup>rd</sup> Round	<b>Last 16</b>	End December 2020
4 <sup>th</sup> Round	<b>Quarter Final</b>	End January 2021
5 <sup>th</sup> Round	<b>Semi Final</b>	End February 2021
6 <sup>th</sup> Round	<b>Final</b>	Early March 2021
